Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation (ALSF) emerged from the front yard lemonade stand of 4-year-old Alexandra "Alex" Scott, who was fighting cancer and wanted to raise money to find cures for all children with cancer. Her spirit and determination inspired others to support her cause, and by the time she passed away at the age of 8, she had raised \$1 million. Since then, the Foundation bearing her name has evolved into a national fundraising movement and is one of the leading funders of pediatric cancer research in the U.S. and Canada.

The Lemon Club is a student-led club that functions under the direction of ALSF to raise awareness and funds for childhood cancer research. Through The Lemon Club, students have the opportunity to engage a broad range of people and resources (e.g. students, teachers, community and forums) about the need for funding childhood cancer research projects. ALSF's Lemon Clubs plan and execute on- and off-campus fundraisers for the duration of their school year. Lemon Club chapters are encouraged to host a variety of awareness and fundraising events to help spread the mission of ALSF and meet their fundraising goals.

Tips for Hosting Your Stand

(or Other Fundraisers)

Set a Goal

Decide how much money you'd like to raise to help kids with cancer so you have a goal in mind. Remember, every \$50 supports one hour of research!

Choose Your Location, Date & Time Wisely

Set up where you find a lot of foot traffic. In the cafeteria at lunch or at events like your school play or sports games are great places to host your fundraiser!

Share Your Event

Tell others about your fundraiser through word of mouth or on social media. As a registered event host, collect donations online by sharing your event page with parents and teachers.

Hold Your Stand or Activity & Have Fun

Think beyond lemonade and have fun activities (e.g. face painting, music, entertainment or silent auctions) at your event.

Ask for Help

Call a local business to sponsor your event (remember to mention that donations are tax-deductible). Your event coach can provide you with an official letter of support written on the Foundation's letterhead with our tax ID.







Making the Most of Your Fundraising Page

When you register your event you will receive your very own virtual headquarters: your fundraising page!

This page is a powerful tool for raising money and promoting your stand or event. You can use it to let everyone know your event details and track your progress toward your goal. Your fundraising page is also how you'll accept online credit card donations. Your supporters can donate directly to your event via your page – just give them the link, and they can click "donate" right on your page.

Here are some tips to make the most of your fundraising page:



- Personalize your page with photos or inspiring messages, and honor a childhood cancer hero!
- Email or share your page on your school's social media channels and ask for donations.
- Make your fundraiser more meaningful by sharing a childhood cancer hero story in your donation ask.
- Remind donors that every donation makes a difference, and be sure to thank them for giving!






Your Fundrasing Page

Buttons to share your fundraising page on social media and in email.


Fundraising progress bar

We are delighted that Lucy Lemonade has chosen to partner with Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation this year in the fight against childhood cancer. Lucy is holding a fundraising event on May 20, 2022 at 111 Lemonade Lane. Please consider supporting their efforts to raise much needed funds and awareness for innovative research projects working to develop better treatments, and ultimately, cures for all childhood cancers.

A little background on our Foundation if you haven't heard of us – Alexandra "Alex" Scott founded Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation on what seemed to be a simple concept. In the year 2000, when Alex was just 4-years-old and battling neuroblastoms, she told her parents that she wanted to have a lemonade stand in her front yard. She surprised everyone when she announced her plan to donate the money from the stand to "her hospital" to help the doctors find a cure for all kids' with cancer. She continued to hold yearly lemonade stands to benefit childhood cancer research with the help of people from all over the world. In August of 2004, Alex passed away at the age of 8, knowing that, with the help of others, she had raised more than \$1 million to help find a cure for all kids with cancer.

Since Alex's very first stand in 2000, more than \$250 million has been raised for childhood cancer research! Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation has funded over 1000 research projects in nearly 150 leading pediatric cancer hospitals throughout the United States and Canada.
